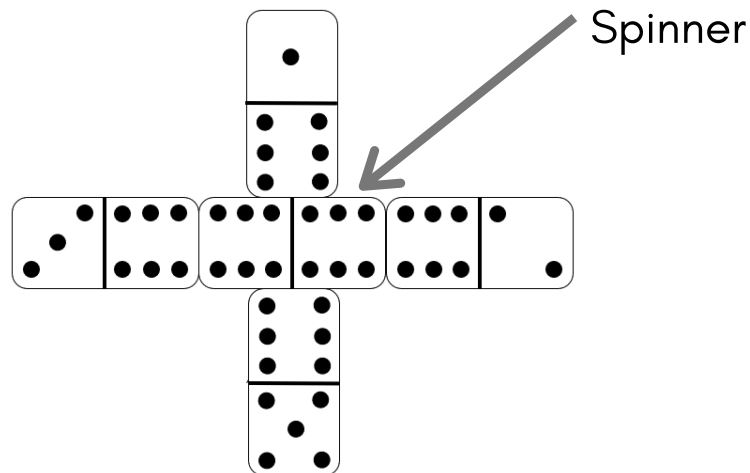
BEFORE YOU PLAY

Dominoes is a classic game played all around the world by all ages.

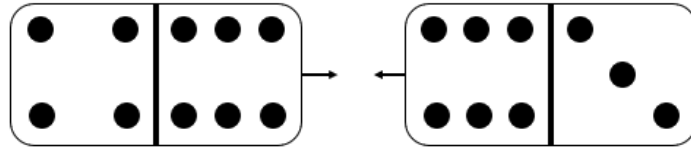
PLAYING THE GAME

It begins with placing all tiles facedown and shuffling them randomly. Each player will choose 7 tiles if it is a 2 person game or 5 tiles if it is a 3 or 4 person game. The remaining dominoes are set aside as the "boneyard" The player that goes first has the highest double domino.

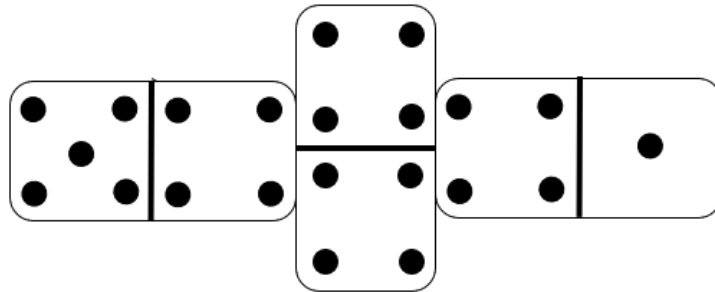
They play this domino first, which can be played in 4 directions and is the only domino that can be.



Players in turn lay tiles onto the open ends of the domino layout with same-number adjacent to same-number as shown below.



This continues at end to end to make a long line of dominoes. Doubles are played perpendicular as shown below.



Play continues with each player placing the tiles. If a player finds they are unable to play any tile they must draw from the boneyard until they find one. The round is over when a player uses all of the dominoes. If there are no tiles left in the boneyard, the player may pass until they are able to play. If no play can resume, the player with the lowest number of dots on all pips is the winner of the round.

SCORING

Once a round has ended, players must tally the total number of pips on the tiles they have left. The total number is awarded to the player who won the round. You can play to whatever score you like!
